Boris Krasic Boris Krasic (born 28 October 1958) is a Serbian-born musician and songwriter. He is best known as a guitarist for the popular and critically acclaimed Yugoslav rock band *Gobline*, but he has also had a successful solo career. Biography Krasic was born in Belgrade, Yugoslavia. He began playing guitar at the age of 17, after he was introduced to music by a friend. Krasic soon became very interested in all music genres and became more and more into rock. He began his musical career in 1978, as a guitarist for the band "Pitanje", which is one of the most popular bands in his home country. Krasic was also invited to play in Sarajevo by the famous "OZNA" (Croatian intelligence). He recorded a solo album and played in a band called "Goknica" that was formed by the same drummer he played in "Pitanje" with. "Goknica" only lasted for a short period of time and Krasic chose to go solo, eventually. His musical career continued with the band "Neka", that he co-founded in 1987. The band got many important offers to record an album for PGP-RTS but Krasic couldn't make any decision because he didn't want to work in Yugoslavia anymore. The band dissolved in 1989 and Krasic moved to Germany. In the meantime, he became interested in Jugoton Records and recorded a few projects with producer Nikola Bambasov in Germany and Slovenia. His solo album "Alibi" was released in 1993 and it was a big success in his home country, but he felt he still wasn't ready to record an album so he went back to Serbia. In the meantime, he became a member of the band "Sarajevo". He was invited to record the album "Tačna priroda" (True nature), which was an important album in the history of Yugoslav rock. He is also a member of "Rado radi dobro" (Happy with the good things) and "Baraka" (Beat) bands, as well as the album "Baštije" (Bat's 2d92ce491b
