On September 4th at the Miller Health Barnoski Center, Marysville Area Chamber of Commerce will present the Great Jobs Challenge 2009, a unique program designed to connect applicants to local employers with career development opportunities. The Great Jobs Challenge is similar to other local job fairs, with employers and service providers at booths offering programs for applicants of all ages. But, the Great Jobs Challenge is uniquely designed to give

high school students a chance to earn extra college credits and their school credit-time. The Great Jobs Challenge is open to high school seniors in the Metro-Detroit area. Seniors interested in attending this event must have a minimum of 20 college credit hours completed and be able to attend a college credit-time program. They must also be attending a traditional high school. High school seniors also must have a 2.5 GPA. High school seniors may receive up to eight college credits from Grand Rapids Community College and will have the opportunity to attend a 10-week summer experience at the Miller

Health Barnoski Center. Seniors must be enrolled in college and must receive college credit for attending this program. To receive college credit from GRCC, seniors must take at least four credits in fall semester and four in spring semester, meeting the minimum number of credits for the school
